IMPORTANT REMINDERS

The competition will be conducted as per the COVID-19 Community Tennis Guidelines for South Australia dated 2 June 2020 and COVID-19 Competition Regulations for South Australia, including any subsequent information issued by Tennis SA.

Remember the principle is - "GET IN - PLAY - GET OUT"

Matches will be conducted in accordance with the 2019/20 Match Administration Rules (except as noted below) and the GDTA: Conduct of Junior Matches. These documents are available on the GDTA website (gdtanet.au).

Matches shall be commenced at 9:00am (Rule 1.7)

Teams may use up to 6 players in each match (Rule 2.3)

Balls - The home team is to supply at least four balls. Divisions 1 & 2 are to use new balls, other divisions may use good quality used balls. (Rule 3)

In Division 1 and Division 2, **all sets are tie-break sets** (with a 7-point tie-break at 6 games all). In all other divisions, **all sets are straight six game sets** with the winner being the first player reach 6 games. (Rule 5.2)

In **Greenball competition**, games will be won by a 'sudden death' point at deuce score (40-all).

Finals Qualification - No player may play in finals matches in a division unless that player has played in no less than (4) minor round matches in that or a lower division. (Rule 12.3)

Each team is responsible for printing their own score sheet before each match.

The GDTA: Conduct of Junior Matches provides the processes to solve and regulate a range of issues with players and behaviours in matches. It is important to note that if a problem cannot be resolved by team supervisors, it must be referred to the Venue Supervisor who makes final decisions.

Interference in Matches

The coaching of, or interference with, players during the progress of a match or set is not permitted, nor should spectators interfere in line calls or score disputes. No players or adults (excepting the Venue Supervisor) are permitted within the court area or courtside during a match except in Green Ball or the lowest division, where an adult may by mutual agreement be permitted to assist in the progress of the match (including scoring). The Venue Supervisor is permitted on the courts at any time if required.

Inclement Weather (Rain)

Once courts are swept (if required) both team supervisors should test the court surface and lines to determine whether it is safe for players. If there is no agreement as to when to resume play, the Venue Supervisor is called to make a decision.

All players must remain at the courts for at least one hour before making a decision to abandon a match and every attempt should be made to get a result.
